Purpose

This Bulletin is intended ONLY for the specific security problems identified below. The problems identified have been rated a criticality level of IMPORTANT.

General release that includes fixes for the following:

- OpenSSL CVE-2016-6304 which may have allowed a denial of service attack to be applied to a memory leak.
- The security protocol SSLv3 was removed from the product, and switches were added to allow disablement of TLS 1.0, TLS 1.1 and TLS 1.2 individually
- An issue in the IPv6 protocol implementation, related to ICMP Packet Too Big (PTB) messages (CVE-2016-10142) that could allow a denial of service attack to be applied
- Prevents the possibility of wireless vulnerability known as Krack (Key Reinstallation Attack)
- Updates to Libtiff to address the following CVEs - CVE-2017-9403, CVE-2017-9404, CVE-2017-7593, CVE-2017-7596, CVE-2017-7597, CVE-2017-7598, CVE-2017-7599, CVE-2017-7600, CVE-2017-7601, CVE-2017-7602, CVE-2016-10266, CVE-2016-10269, CVE-2016-10270
