## Australian Cyber Security Rules 2025 Compliance

### Purpose

To communicate compliance with the Australia Security Standard for Consumer Grade Relevant Products.

### Description

Australia's new security standards for consumer smart devices, under the [Cyber Security Act 2024](#) and [Rules 2025](#), mandate no universal default passwords, require vulnerability reporting channels, and demand transparent security update periods (with an end date), enforced from March 2026 to protect consumers by lifting IoT security, requiring compliance statements, and allowing for recalls for non-compliant products like smart TVs, cameras, and home assistants (excluding PCs/phones/tablets).
